

Recognition of words related to different parts of the speech¹

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Time, which is needed in order to understand to what part of the speech the word is related, was studied in the article. Nouns, adjectives, verbs and adverbs as long as “non words” - all are different by the length (from 4 to 12 letters in each) were presented to respondents. As a result, the time of the recognition (TR) of words in individual data depended only on the length of the word. In group data the statistically important difference between TR for adverbs and nouns was discovered, however this was not shown at any individual case. As a result, the experimental hypothesis was denied. Some additional methods, as involvement of different age people who have various levels of speech development, were suggested in order to test the hypothesis.
