## **To the problem of change the internal position of person in life-span development**

In the article methodological potential of usage the concept of internal position in developmental psychology had been analyzed. The potential of application of this concept for the integration of age-oriented and subject-centered approaches in psychological study of human life had described. Author observed this concept in concern with L. Bozhovich's subject-centered approach of the development of child's personality as free and self-reliant subject. Author analyzed the development of child's subjectivity and internal position at the basis of theoretical principles formed by L. Bozhovich. The main change of internal position in transition from adolescence to adulthood is the appearance of the relation toward human's own life as an object of practical transformation; qualitative changes of internal position over the time of human life were shown.
